COMPETITION CONDITIONS

Entry fees must accompany entry forms. No entrant will be allowed to compete until entry fees are paid.

Competitions shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as adopted by The Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews, Scotland, together with such Local Rules as may be enforced during the event. If a dispute arises on any point, it shall be decided by the Committee in charge of the competition, whose decision is final. Provided however, the Committee, if in doubt, shall have the right to refer any such dispute to Golf Australia (GA), whose decision shall be final.

Players must be prepared to play when called upon by the starter. Should vacancies occur, the Committee shall have the power to alter the draw.

Entries are restricted to Amateurs who are members of clubs affiliated with GA, or of Golf Clubs registered with such Overseas Associations as are affiliated with or recognized by this Association, or of clubs affiliated with GA. The Committee shall have the right to refuse the entry of any person without being required to give any reason for such refusal.

Competitors must state their Home Club and their GA Handicap.

The Committee may, in the event of bad weather, or for any other reason, either cancel or shorten any contest, or allocate another day. Should a tie occur in the Scratch Event, the winner will be decided by a sudden death playoff. Ties in the Handicap events shall be decided by count back as per AGU or WGA table.

No Competitor shall be awarded more than one major trophy on any one day.

The Committee shall have the power to limit the number of entries in any event and grade players as it sees fit.

All Entrants will be inducted as an Honorary Member for the duration of the Competition.

MOTORISED TRANSPORT

In all events other than Events 2 & 4 Motorised transport may be used.

In Events 2 & 4 it is prohibited for a player or his caddie to ride in or on a motorised vehicle unless specific permission has been granted by the Event Committee. Penalty two strokes at the first hole. Procedure when breach discovered: Use of any unauthorised form of transportation must be discontinued immediately upon discovery that a breach has occurred.

Otherwise, the player is disqualified.
