## **General Conditions of Play**

### **2025 Colac Golf Club Ladies Open + Perpetual Plate**

- 1. Entry Fees:** Event fees must be paid at the time of entry. No payments will be accepted on the day.
- 2. Match Committee:** The Match Committee will make all arrangements and has the authority to alter or make variations to the program or order of play as necessary. They may also modify grades for the event.
- 3. GA Handicap:** Limited to below 43.5.
- 4. Eligibility:** Entries are limited to amateurs who are members of Golf Australia or affiliated clubs recognized by Golf Australia and hold a GA handicap. The Match & Play Committee reserves the right to refuse entry without explanation.
- 5. Rules of Play:** The tournament will adhere to the Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews, along with local course rules. Disputes must be reported to the Match & Play Committee within 15 minutes of the day's play completion.
- 6. Reporting Time:** All players must report to the Event Organizer in the Colac Golf Club clubhouse at least 30 minutes prior to hit-off and be ready to play when called by the starter.
- 7. Pace of Play:** Rule 6-7 (Pace of Play) will be strictly enforced. Groups must maintain their position on the course. Penalties may be issued for delays caused by groups failing to keep pace.
- 8. Ties:** For A Grade Gross event, if there is a tie, the winner will be determined by a sudden death play-off on Hole 18, continuing on the 18<sup>th</sup> until a winner is found. For B & C Grades, as well as Nett event, ties will be resolved using the Countback system according to Golf Australia guidelines.
- 9. Prize Trophy Limitations:** No competitor may win more than one major prize per day, except for the Team event - Perpetual Trophy and NTPs.
- 10. Visitor Status:** All visitors to Colac Golf Club during the tournament will be considered honorary members for the day.
- 11. Handicap Confirmation:** Grade divisions will be determined after the closing of entries.
- 12. Late Entries:** Late entries may be accepted after the closing date if field capacities have not been reached.
- 13. Refunds:** Full refunds will be provided to players before the draw is published.
