In Cooking for Community classes, participants make use of our registered kitchen to learn how to cook in larger quantities, practiced safe food handling and safe work practices.

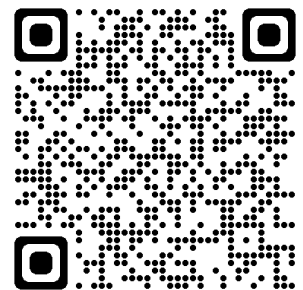
